

IMPORT OF MOTOR BIKES INTO AUSTRALIA

- a) **Import Permit**: Please ensure you apply for and are granted an import permit for the motor bike from the Department of Transport and Regional Services in Canberra **before** shipping to Australia. **Under no circumstances should you ship the bike until you are absolutely sure you have been granted this import permit. It is now an offence to ship a bike to Australia without the required permit being first granted. DTRS have also indicated that they will reject any applications for bikes arriving here without the required permit.**
- b) **GST/Duty Payable**: Please note that 10% GST will be payable on the motor bike which is calculated on the Australian Customs value of the bike + transport and insurance costs.. This tax will be required to be paid to Australian Customs before they will release the bike.
